Teen Safe Driving Program

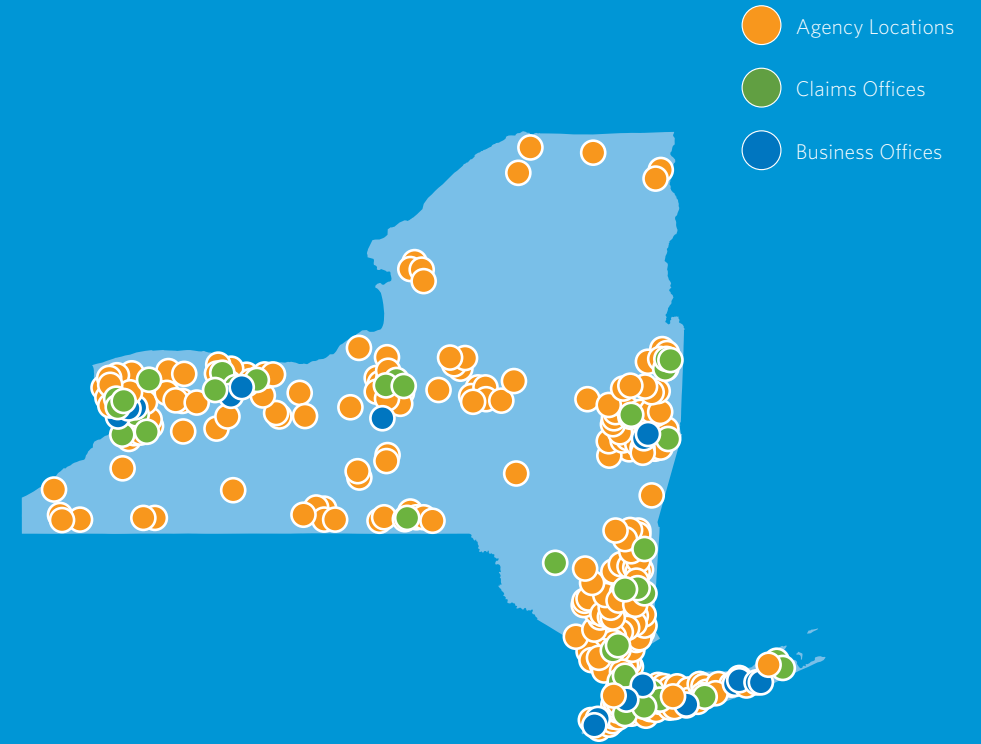
We provide programs to educate new drivers and their parents about smart driving habits to help make the roads safer for all.
